The presence of a quorum was noted and the meeting was called to order at 6:09pm. The public was duly notified in compliance with the District's open meeting policy.

2. Approve Agenda.

4. General Manager's Report.

4.1. Update of Recent Events & Projects.

4.1.A. On March 6, 2020 there was a fire at Lift Station #14. The fire reached the meter can, lightning arrestor, and the junction box prior to being extinguished. All were destroyed. The fire was not caused by an equipment malfunction. Repairs were made and the station was back in service the morning of March 12, 2020.

4.1.B. On March 6, 2020 a sinkhole was detected in the middle of Analii Street which was caused by a boring contractor hired to install fiber optic conduits. Repairs were made and the street re-opened prior to midnight. The boring contractor, Delta Directional Drilling, will be billed for the damages.

4.1.C. Item 9.6. on the agenda is a motion to award the quote to the highest bidder from the two received for the sale of all surplus water meters. Once a vendor is awarded arrangements will be made to complete the sale.

4.1.D. The necessary documents and drawings for the Lift Station #17B Project has been sent to MDEQ for approval.

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4.1.E. The engineering for the Water System Hydraulic Model Project has been completed.

4.1.F. Phase I of the Scada Improvements Project, which includes the installation of new PLC's and radios, is scheduled for the first week of March. Phase II & III are scheduled for the month of March. Operator training is scheduled for the end of March. Final system O&M manuals are scheduled to be delivered in April.

4.1.G. The reverse auction bidding process for the combination sewer vacuum/jetter/hydro-excavator truck commenced on February 12, 2020 through February 26, 2020. Advertisements were placed in the Sea Coast Echo, State of MS Portal, DWSD Website, and Central Bidding Auction House. Bid specs were available through Central Bidding. The reverse auction was conducted by Central Bidding online live on March 4, 2020 from 10:00am through 10:30am. Sansom Equipment was the only bid submitted. Sansom Equipment's bid meets the specification requirements.

4.1.H. District legal counsel and Purcell legal counsel have worked together to execute a special warranty deed for the WWTP land exchange. Item 8.2. on the agenda is a motion to approve the real property transfer.
