The presence of a quorum was noted and the meeting was called to order at 4:00pm. The public was duly notified in compliance with the District's open meeting policy.

 - 5.1. Update of Projects & Recent Events.
 - **5.1.A.** Recognition two departing commissioners: (1)Mr. Kenneth Edmonds, Jr. and (2)Mr. Robert Redd. They served the District and community well.
 - **5.1.B.** The District continues to operate under CDC, MS State Dept. of Health, and Hancock County Emergency Management Agency guidelines and protocol for COVID-19 precautions.
 - **5.1.C.** On October 28, 2020 Diamondhead sustained a direct hit from Hurricane Zeta. The District responded within minutes of winds dying down to Tropical Storm force ratings. There was a house fire on Alewa Place and a water main break on Honomu Court during the storm. Power and communications were lost to the wells and sewer lift stations. The District monitored the water tower pressure and throttled down the mainline valve on Honomu Court to gain control of the water tower level. Wells were manually operated using diesel generator power. The District cleared the streets with a backhoe so that all systems could be reachable. The District manned the wells and the tower throughout the night to ensure there was no loss of system pressure. At daybreak following the storm, the District was able to re-establish communication systems which allowed for remote monitoring of the wells and tower. The

morning after the storm a tree removal service was contacted to remove a large tree from Honomu Court, which then allowed the District to repair the water main break. Clean up and various repairs throughout the District area continued through October 31, 2020 and damage assessments are being made.

- **5.1.D.** All major components for the Lift Station 17B Project have been installed. The contractor is waiting on Coast Electric to provide power to the site; however, this has been placed on hold until power restoration efforts from Hurricane Zeta have been completed. The remaining project work cannot continue until power is provided.
- **5.1.E.** The Water Facilities Plan Project is on schedule and approximately 55% complete. A progress meeting is scheduled for November 18, 2020.
